# Adobe Creative Cloud Network Endpoints

This document contains lists of network endpoints for websites and specific services that are offered as part of the Adobe® Creative Cloud™. As explained in *Controlling Access to Creative Cloud Services*, a firewall can be configured to block some of these endpoints so as to prevent access to Creative Cloud services by users in a customer organization. Blocking the services and websites listed in this document will *not* block Creative Cloud Packager access to desktop applications.

The table below contains a list of all of the desktop applications included with a Creative Cloud membership.

Many of the endpoints listed in the above tables use globally defined hostnames that may resolve differently in different regions of the world. For example, the website URLs adoberevel.com and acrobat.com and adobe.com resolve to geographically specific websites www.adoberevel.com and www.acrobat.com and www.adobe.com, respectively. In order to be effective, firewall rules must block access to the regional endpoints as well as the globally defined endpoints.
