What's New in Power PDF 3 for Windows

This document contains information on the new features and capabilities of the Windows version of Power PDF 3. Items are categorized by theme, and within each category, features are listed in order of most important/broadly appealing to items that are a little less widely used. Key new features are highlighted.

Document Compatibility

A core customer need that's satisfied by PDF software is the ability to create documents that will be fully compatible with other downstream readers and document processing software. Read on below to see how we've enhanced a Power PDF user's ability to create the most compatible PDFs possible.

- Note: User must login, and then can have Power PDF remember their login details to bypass this step in the future.
- Note: User must have a DocuSign account. There is a 30-day free trial available.
- Users enjoy all the benefits of secure document workflows with the industry's leading e-signature service, and save time since they can complete this task right from the PDF interface.

DocuSign – Validate a DocuSign digital signature
[Key New Feature]

- The DocuSign root certificate is installed with Power PDF by default, so users can validate DocuSign signatures by clicking "Signatures" along the left side ribbon and then "Verify Signatures", or on the top ribbon by clicking "Security", "Document Signatures" and "Verify Signatures"
- Customers who work with DocuSign digital signatures will be up and running quickly as they will not have to spend time finding and installing the DocuSign root certificate into Power PDF first.

Collaboration

Efficiently creating and editing PDF documents by collaborating in real time with colleagues is growing in importance within the target market for PDF software. Customers should understand that there's a better alternative to their current process, which may involve multiple steps in different software tools, which will make them more productive.
