

# Unified management console

## Software client app.

Enable workers to connect to their virtual worktop from the device of their choice, including Windows, macOS, iOS, Linux, Chrome, and Android with Horizon Client. Or use a web browser as an HTML client.

#### **Cross-pod management**

Unify monitoring and management of images, applications, and lifecycles across on-premises, hybrid and multi-cloud deployments Horizon Control Plane.

#### Remote security access

Enable users outside the corporate network to access their virtual desktops and published applications securely without using a VPN, with Unified Access Gateway.

#### **End user authentication**
